Offering Report

The general fund offering and net online contributions for December 14, 2014 were \$9,911.52. In addition, \$6,003.88 has been contributed toward the \$25,000 mortgage challenge match.

As of the third week in December expenses for the year were \$423,400 and contributions \$378,696 for a shortfall of \$44,704. Because we started the year with a balance and expenses will likely be below budget, we need about \$39,000 to finish the year in the black. Strong year end contributions for a number of years have allowed us to do that. The church board encourages you to give generously so we do not need to draw on reserve funds.
