- A **cry area**, where parents with a fussy child can listen to the service, is available in the conference room to your left as you leave the sanctuary.
- Children 3 years of age thorough Grade 3 are dismissed prior to the sermon for **Children's Church** held downstairs each Sunday. Children will return to the sanctuary during the closing hymn.
- **Hearing magnifiers** are available at the sound booth for hearing impaired individuals.

There will be a guest speaker today in the *Christian, Muslim, Friend* Sunday School class. Imam Fatih Akdemir, a Muslim scholar and practitioner, originally from Turkey and a co-worker of Ulli Kemm, will share with us and address questions you may have.
