- A **nursery**, staffed by volunteers during worship and Sunday school, can be accessed through the fellowship hall annex, and is available at any time for infants through children 2 years old. A microwave is available in the kitchen to heat formula.
- A **cry area**, where parents with a fussy child can listen to the service, is available in the conference room to your left as you leave the sanctuary.
- Children 3 years of age thorough Grade 3 are dismissed prior to the sermon for **Children's Church** held downstairs each Sunday. Children will return to the sanctuary during the closing hymn.
- Children of all ages are always welcome in the worship service.
- **Hearing magnifiers** are available at the sound booth.

This afternoon at 1:15 **Cambodian missionaries, Heap and Jennifer Him**, will speak of their work and involvement with a school and therapy program for children with brain injuries. Everyone is invited to attend. Those staying for the presentation are also invited to the potluck lunch beginning at noon.
