Total Tithes and Offerings including online giving for Sunday January 7 was \$8,151.27 of which \$10 was for mortgage reduction. The 2018 approved budget requires **\$8,400** weekly income.

Some helpful information:

- So we may be aware of your visit, you're invited to complete a **Welcome Card** (available in the pews) and place it in the offering plate when it is passed.
- **Information about Slate Hill Mennonite** and Mennonites in general is available at the Welcome Center.
- **Restrooms and a coat rack** are located at the end of the hallway toward the left as you leave the sanctuary. A **family restroom** is located off the conference room. All restrooms are equipped with **changing tables**.
- A **nursery**, staffed by volunteers during worship and Sunday school, can be accessed through the fellowship hall annex, and is available any time for infants through children 2 years old. A microwave is available in the kitchen to heat formula.
- A **cry area**, where parents with a fussy child can listen to the service, is available in the conference room to your left as you leave the sanctuary.
- Children 3 years of age thorough Grade 3 are dismissed prior to the sermon for **Children's Church** held downstairs each Sunday. Children will return to the sanctuary during the closing hymn.
- Children of all ages are always welcome in the worship service and **activity packets** for their use are just outside the sanctuary.
- **Hearing magnifiers** are available at the sound booth.
